- I. **Call to Order:**
  - a. Meeting was called at 14:00 and in attendance: Trustee Strzelecki, Police Chief Tigera, Police Deputy Chief Romano, Sergeant Boba, Fire Chief Feld, Fire Deputy Chief Greiner and Member Fidanza.

  - a. Discuss the outcome of the Finance Committee in regards to the Police seizure and DUI accounts pursuant to Federal and State seizure laws. Police Chief Tigera informed the Public Safety Committee that on August 3, 2022 the Niles Police Department made a presentation to the Finance Committee. The items discussed included, Niles Police Seizure and DUI accounts pursuant to Federal and State Seizure Laws. Police Chief Tigera went on to state that the Finance Committee approved the Police Department request to handle this account under the guidance of Federal and State Seizure laws. This subject was considered informative so no action was necessary.

- b. Glenview Dispatch Contract: Police Deputy Chief Romano informed the committee that the Police Department is requesting that the Village of Niles approve the renewal of the contract between the Glenview Dispatch and the Niles Police Department. This is a 6 (six) year contract which runs from 2023 – 2029. Fire Chief Feld made a motion to approve the contract renewal for Glenview Dispatch to provide dispatch services to the Niles Police Department. A roll call was taken: Police Chief Tigera – approved, Fire Chief Feld – approved, Trustee Strzelecki – approved and Member Fidanza – approved. Motion passed.
