ARREST

Niles, IL – The Niles Police Department was dispatched to the Little Caesars Restaurant at 7201 Dempster at 6:35pm on 5/10/21. A male suspect presented a note to restaurant staff stating he had a gun and demanding cash. The restaurant employee kept the note and contacted NPD. No cash was given to the suspect. The suspect fled the restaurant on foot. A firearm was never displayed.

Niles units responding to the scene located a suspect matching the description given by dispatch, on Shermer Road. This suspect was positively identified by restaurant staff as the person that presented the note. The suspect was taken into custody and transported to NPD.

The suspect provided a written statement to Investigators.

After consulting with the Cook County State's Attorney's Office the suspect was charged as follows. The suspect will be held at NPD until Bond Hearing at the 2nd District Courthouse in Skokie on 5/12/2021.
