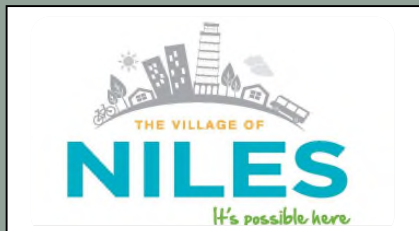

INTRODUCTION

Good news. **Your street is on the list of streets to potentially be repaired next year.** The resurfacing project is scheduled to take place in the 2023 construction season. Substantial completion of the project may not occur until late October / early November. The project is part of an ongoing infrastructure improvement project that will improve services to Niles residents and businesses.

WHAT KIND OF WORK WILL BE DONE?

In general, the project will include:

- Repairs to storm drain inlets and other utilities.
- Sidewalk and Curb & Gutter spot repairs.
- Removal of all or part of the asphalt pavement.
- Placement of new asphalt pavement.
- Restoration. (Lawn, Driveway, etc.).

WHAT HAPPENS TO MY STREET ACCESS?

During construction, your street, driveway, and sidewalk access will remain intact to the greatest extent possible. Due to the nature of the project however, there will be instances where parking, driveway, and pedestrian access will be altered or lost for a period of time. Every step possible will be taken to minimize disruption.

WILL THE CONSTRUCTION AFFECT MY PROPERTY?

Wherever grass or sidewalk is removed, it will be replaced before the end of the project. The goal for the project is to improve the infrastructure and roadway, we plan to leave the project looking better than when we started.

WILL I RECEIVE ADDITIONAL NOTIFICATIONS?
