Burglary Arrest

Niles, IL – On 5/23/2023, between 5:30 and 6:00 AM, a female suspect used a key to gain access to three buildings in a condo complex in the 7000 block of Touhy Avenue, Niles. The suspect then opened several banks of mailboxes in the building lobbies with a key and stole an unknown amount of mail.

The suspect was identified by NPD detectives through video surveillance. The suspect was taken into custody in Chicago on 6/20/2023 by U.S. Postal Inspectors and Chicago Police Officers for a separate case.

During a subsequent interview with NPD detectives, the suspect admitted to committing the Niles condo burglaries. The Cook County State's Attorney's Office approved the following:

Burglary (3 counts): Class 3 Felony (720 ILCS 5/19-1)

The suspect was transported to bond court on 6/21/2023.
