### SHOOTING INVESTIGATION: **UPDATE**

**Niles, IL** – Niles detectives investigated this incident and determined the 33-year-old male, listed as Subject #1 in the original media release, was the suspect in this incident. He had a verbal dispute with the victim, Subject #2, inside a residence in the 9200 block of Woodland Drive. During the dispute, the suspect produced a handgun and discharged it in the direction of the victim, striking him in an upper extremity. The victim was then able to disarm the suspect and return fire in self-defense, striking the offender in the torso. There was only one firearm involved in this incident.

The Cook County State's Attorney's Office approved the following charges against the suspect:

- Unlawful Use of a Weapon by a Convicted Felon (One Class 2 felony count and one Class 3 felony count)
- Aggravated Unlawful Use of a Weapon by a Parolee (Class 2 felony)
- Aggravated Unlawful Use of a Weapon (Two Class 2 felony counts)
- Endangering the Life or Health of a Child (Class A misdemeanor)

**Suspect:** Anthony C. Walker, 33-year-old male  
LKA: 9200 block of Woodland Drive, Niles, IL

The suspect will attend a detention hearing on 10/28/2023. All persons are presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
