## Mortgage Relief Project Documentation

*Please bring the following items to the event:*

- Mortgage Statement
- 2011 & 2012 W-2 & tax return with all schedules (2013 return if available).
- Copy of rental agreement, if necessary
- 2 months of recent paystubs
- Budget of household expenses
- Documentation of other income
- 2 months of recent bank statements
- Recent Utility Bill
- Profit/Loss, if self-employed (last 6 months)

**Don't worry if you do not have all the docs on the day of the event.** You can still meet with a HUD-Certified counseling agency or your lender and get the process started.
