Sexual Assault Arrest

Niles, IL- On October 10, 2015 at approximately 7:15 a.m. the 17 year old Juvenile Male Victim of Glenview was inside a meditation room in the King Spa in the 800 block of Civic Center drive taking a nap. NGUYEN entered the mediation room and found the victim sleeping. The Victim awoke several minutes later finding NGUYEN was performing a sex act on the Victim. The Victim pushed NGUYEN away, and NGUYEN ran out of the room. The Victim notified a manager who contacted the Niles Police. NGUYEN was located and subsequently interviewed and taken into custody. He was transported to the Niles Police Department.

The Cook County State's Attorney Office was contacted. An Assistant State's Attorney responded to the Niles Police Department. The Assistant State's Attorney interviewed both the Victim and Offender. Subsequently, the Assistant State's Attorney approved a single Felony charge of Criminal Sexual Assault, a Class One Felony.

NGUYEN was processed and held for a bond hearing.

Charge – 1 Count of 720 ILCS 5/11-1.20 Criminal Sexual Assault (Class 1 Felony)

Initial Court Date – October 21st, 2015 at 9:00 a.m., room 105, at the Skokie Court House, 5600 Old Orchard Road, Skokie, IL

A Class 1 Felony is punishable by four to 15 years in prison. An extended term class 1 felony is punishable by 15 to 30 years. All suspects are innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
