Dear Niles Resident:

Winter is upon us and with any harsh winter comes snow and ice. Please take some time to familiarize yourself with the Village of Niles snow procedures.

The Village's goal is to ensure that emergency vehicles can make their way around our Village. Major routes take priority and are cleared first, followed by snow/bus routes, then local roads/side streets. Alleys and parking spaces are the last priority.

In your neighborhood, the following rules apply when snow is on the ground.

- It is illegal per Village Ordinance to shovel snow into the streets and alleys.
- It is the resident's responsibility to keep trash and recycling containers off the street at all times.
- It is the resident's responsibility to keep the roadway clear of park vehicles.
- Vehicles in violation of Village Ordinances will be towed. Only the Village Police Department shall authorize the towing of motor vehicles and only under certain circumstances.
