Assist to Northbrook Police Department Armed Robbery Arrest

Niles, IL - At 2:45 p.m. Glenview Dispatch notified the Niles Police Department that the Northbrook Police Department was following two Armed Robbery Suspects who were driving a vehicle into Niles. Dispatch notified the Niles responding units that the Offenders were traveling southbound on Milwaukee Avenue and were approaching Oakton Street. As Niles Patrol Units were traveling northbound on Milwaukee, the Offending vehicle pulled into the parking lot of Jerry's Fruit market at 7901 Milwaukee Avenue, followed by the Northbrook Police Department Officers. Niles units boxed the car in and the two offenders fled on foot jumping the fence into the Oasis Water Park Pool area where they were surrounded by Niles, Morton Grove, and Northbrook officers. One offender gave up after K-9 Ace was deployed, and the other offender jumped the fence and tried to run. A Niles Police Officer ordered the offender to stop, but he refused, he was subsequently a Taser was deployed. The second Offender was taken into custody without further incident. The second offender was transported to Lutheran General Hospital per department policy and was under guard of the Northbrook Police Department.
