Criminal Damage to Property

Niles, IL - On 7/30/2018 at about 7:18 a.m. a Niles Police Officer responded to a report of Criminal Damage to Property that occurred on July 29, 2018 at approximately 12:45 p.m. The complainant reported that upon arriving at work it was discovered that someone had spray painted gang related graffiti on the walls at Emerson Middle School located at 8101 north Cumberland Avenue.

The complainant reviewed building surveillance cameras to determine that exact time that the incident occurred and the incident started on July 29, 2018 at 12:45 p.m. and ended about 1:50 p.m. The Offender is observed climbing into some construction equipment and removing a can of orange spray paint. The offender then sprayed the east side of the building and circles around to the front of the main entrance and finishes spray painting.

Surveillance video captured an image of the offender who appears to be a Male Black 18-25 year of age, average heights with a muscular build. He has short black hair, brown eyes and a goatee. An image is attached to this release.

The complainant estimates the damage to repair or replace the concrete at \$10,000. This incident is currently being investigated and we are requesting that if anyone recognizes this person to please contact the Niles Police Department Detective Bureau at 847-588-6500.

Criminal Damage to State Supported Property is a Class 3 Felony.
