



PRINT MATERIAL DISTRIBUTION RULES (A permit is not required)

1. You may place or distribute materials:
 - in railings or door grids of houses.
 - on windshields of cars on the street.
 - on windshields of cars in parking lots (advise store owner or property manager).
 - on public streets, sidewalks and other public gathering places as long as traffic is NOT affected.
2. By Federal Law, you may not place materials in or on any mailbox.
3. You may NOT:
 - ring a doorbell or knock on the door of a home or apartment.
 - place materials where a NO SOLICITORS OR PEDDLERS sign, or a similar sign is posted.
 - impede traffic flow.
4. Hours for distribution are 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Saturday. Distribution is not allowed any time on Sunday or national holidays.
5. If a property owner/resident orders you off the property, you must comply. From the sidewalk to the house is considered private property. Driveways are private property. The sidewalk is considered public property.
6. If distributing materials at a business or on private property, it is the responsibility of the distributor, or organization represented by the distributor, to obtain permission from the business owner or property manager of said business or property.
7. Please be mindful of littering.
