Bank Robbery

Niles, IL – On September 28, 2018 at about 11:00 a.m. the Niles Police Department received a 911 call about a Bank Robbery that had just occurred at the PNC Bank located at 8990 N. Milwaukee Avenue, Niles, IL. The Offender described as a Male White, 25-35 years of age, 5’9” tall, weighing between 175 to 200 pounds, wearing a blue Chicago Cubs baseball cap with a red brim, sunglasses and a two toned grey/black zippered jacket and blue jeans, entered the bank and presented the teller a note declaring a robbery. The teller handed over approximately 2,000 United States Currency and the offender exited the bank heading west on Ballard street.

Upon Officers arrival they were unable to locate the offender. The offender did not display or indicate that he had a weapon of any kind.
