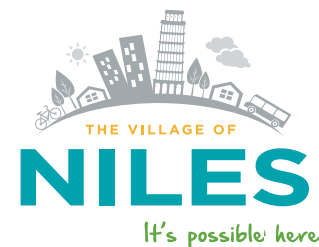

- ▶ **COUNSELING**  
through a holistic perspective embracing the needs of the whole person. Services are available to children, adolescents, adults and seniors.
- ▶ **FOOD PANTRY**  
with generous community donations, we provide this service to those in need. We also have a limited supply of personal hygiene items and clothing available as well.
- ▶ **FINANCIAL WELLNESS**  
short term financial support is provided to residents in need of support.
- ▶ **MEDIATION**  
free conflict resolution services available, provided by the Center for Conflict Resolution.
- ▶ **SENIOR SUPPORT**  
a dedicated team of Social Workers are available to meet the needs of our Seniors and their families.
- ▶ **CRISIS SUPPORT**  
evenings, weekends and holidays, Family Services has a dedicated Crisis Team available for assistance.
- ▶ **COMMUNITY EDUCATION / TRAINING**
