2nd Suspect Arrested for Aggravated Discharge of a Firearm

Niles, IL – On 10/27/2019 at 0320 hours Detectives from the Niles Police Department took into custody a second suspect involved in the incident that occurred September 22, 2019 at approximately 3:22 a.m. at the Music Box Club, located at 7867 N. Milwaukee Avenue. During the course of the investigation Detectives developed information linking a second suspect to this incident. As a result of that information a warrant was obtained for the suspect's arrest. On 10/27/2019 the Maywood Police Department assisted in a traffic stop on the suspect in Maywood and took the suspect into custody. The suspect was transported to the Niles Police Department without incident.

The Cook County State's Attorney's Office reviewed the facts of the incident and the suspect's involvement and approved a felony charge of Aggravated Discharge of a Firearm. The suspect was booked, processed and held for a bond hearing.

This investigation is still active and ongoing.
