Covid-19 Coronavirus Re:

The Village of Niles has been working around the clock to deliver vital Village services and assist residents, businesses, and manufacturers during the Covid-19 crisis. Governor Pritzker issued a state-wide "Stay-at-Home" order, which took effect Saturday, March 21, 2020 at 5 P.M. and will last through April 7. All residents shall remain in their home during this time, with exceptions for essential needs like obtaining food and visiting doctors.

Rest assured that the Village's police, fire, and public works services will all continue during this event. Regular garbage pickup will continue, but loose items that are not in a bag or cart will NOT be accepted. The Niles Free Bus will use its weekend schedule, with no early morning runs, 7 days a week beginning Tuesday, March 24 (the first run will switch to a 9:33 am start time for the 411 route, 9:43 am for the 410 route and 9:30 for the 412 route). Village facilities remain closed to the public.

Niles businesses have a multitude of questions given all the uncertainty of this situation. We understand. The Village is currently evaluating various types of assistance programs for businesses. We are also looking for leadership and guidance from federal, state, and county government agencies. The Village anticipates deferment of most Village fees, taxes, and licensing until more information is gathered and evaluated on the appropriate mechanisms to help our local businesses, manufacturers, and services. Village staff and the Niles Village Board are examining various scenarios and timelines. We are fully aware of the severity of challenges facing your businesses. We plan to implement a business strategy in the coming days and will post any updates as they become available.
